
Easily Spot New Features With Temporary Highlighting


How long will the highlighting last?

- New entry fields (a) = 30 days
- New features (b) = first 10 times displayed on-screen



Turn off highlighting at any time - Tools> Options > Display Tab





Speed Up Data Entry: New Drop Down Lists

Limited/short validation lists replaced with simple drop-down selection. Find these time-savers in both Protocol and Site Description.

NEW Save Time with Merge Feature: Replace

Previously, the *Merge* tool only added information to the current study. The new *Replace* feature deletes old/incorrect information and replaces with selected components. Update the trial map randomization at the same time!

Steps to Replace Crop and/or Pest Description

- 1. Tools > Merge > from ARM Study ...
- 2. Select the Protocol/Trial to copy the new information from and click OK
- 3. Select "Add protocol description" or select "Add site description" (when working in a trial) and click OK
- 4. Check Crop and/or Pest Description
- 5. Select Replace for merging method and click OK

NEW Increase Assessment Data Accuracy with Rating Unit Min/Max Fields

Enter custom range for smallest and largest number valid for the assessment. Units with defined data limits (e.g. percent, pH, etc) are auto-filled. Entering data out of range triggers an alert.

Note: ARM Action codes defining data limits no longer exist. Data limits are now set in only one place (previously set in Action Code, Rating Type, and/or Unit).
